



### Discretionary Assignments

Consider the following questions and prepare an outline for an answer to each of them:

1. If we accept the critiques of morality which are formulated, among others, by Nietzsche, how can we think of an ethical life? How does the social life look like without the existence of transcendent moral principles?
2. Try to explain the nature of true life in the context of Foucault's College de France lectures and the notion of Parrhesia. What does it have to do with the idea of the beautiful life? What is the importance of the Cynics for Foucault in this regard?
3. Explain the role of the Stoic ethics in relation to the Stoic physics and the Stoic logic in Deleuze's reading in Logic of Sense. What is the role of the event here? What does happiness have to do with the Stoic cosmological thought?
4. What does it take to say that ethics has an ontological nature? Try to answer this question in relation with the thoughts of three philosophers that we discussed.
