

Article Processing Charge policy

Inscriptions is an open-access international journal for contemporary thinking on philosophy, psycho-analysis, and the arts published by Tankebanen forlag. The journal's Editorial Board has decided that it is necessary to increase the journal's funding in order to maintain our current activities, introduce new, important services of value to our authors, readers, and the wider community, including Digital Object Identifiers (DOIs), and to ensure our long-term sustainability. Therefore, *Inscriptions* introduces the following policy regarding Article Processing Charges from our Volume 6 (2023):

- **Purpose:** Article Processing Charges (APCs) are introduced to offset expenses and to ensure the long-term viability of the peer-reviewed open-access journal *Inscriptions*;
- **Timing:** APCs will be introduced from Volume 6, Number 1, with publication in mid-January 2023;
- **Procedure:** APCs will be levied after the approval by external reviewers and the editors of an article for publication. Authors will receive proofs and publication will take place pending payment;
- **Fee:** Authors are charged €150 / €120 (students and the unwaged) payable to Tankebanen forlag through PayPal. Authors can pay with a credit or debit card or by charging their PayPal account;
- **Exemptions:** Members of *Inscriptions*' Editorial Board and Advisory Panel are exempted from APCs;
- **Reimbursements:** If an article for some reason is not published by *Inscriptions* within a year of approval authors will have their APCs reimbursed.
